Experience University Research (EUR)

EUR daily classes include approximately 1.5 hours for **Academic Presentation Skills** and approximately 1.5 hours for **Research Methodology**.

Students will have a choice of **University Elective** (1 unit, 12 hours) taught by UCI faculty and field experts.

Academic disciplines

may include *Engineering, Social Ecology, Business, Entrepreneurship and Fashion Design*.

Groups of 3-5 students will meet with **Conversation Partners** approximately 6 hours/week to practice English and learn about American university life.

Students will also learn about UC admissions, majors, and facilities through custom **Presentations** and **Tours**.

General Information:

1. Students will have access to **UCI libraries, computers**, etc. and receive a University **Division of Continuing Education ID card**, which can be used to obtain a **Photo ID Card** at UC Items if desired.
2. UC Irvine has campus **Wi-Fi** available (**FREE**) for those who bring their Laptop/ Notebook Computers. **UCI computers** are available in various locations around the campus and in the Main Library.
3. All **Activities** are organized by UCI and will be accompanied by UCI undergraduate students.
4. Students will have the opportunity to participate in **FREE Activities** throughout the program, such as sports with international students, dance workshops, and more. The Activities staff can also suggest good places to shop, concerts, sports, etc. Information will be available upon arrival during the orientation and at the Activities Desk.
