There will be 4 breakout sessions hosting by a group of 6 UK universities simultaneously. Each session lasts for 15 minutes and runs 4 times. University representatives will give a briefing about their universities and rotate to the next room every 15 minutes. Students will only need to stay in the same virtual breakout room throughout the event.

After the presentation, students/parents can either book a one-to-one meeting (by indicating in the registration form) afterwards or meet them in the evening time for admissions advice.

Evening Session: Webinars and online counselling

The evening session (18.30 – 20.30 HKT) will be open to all secondary school students, parents, teachers and careers counsellors from Hong Kong and Macau. In this 5-day event, there will be 2 live webinars organised per day. Each session will be presented by 2-3 UK universities representatives to talk about a joint topic, including:
