Your aim in Year 4 is **20 minutes** of reading, 4 times a week.

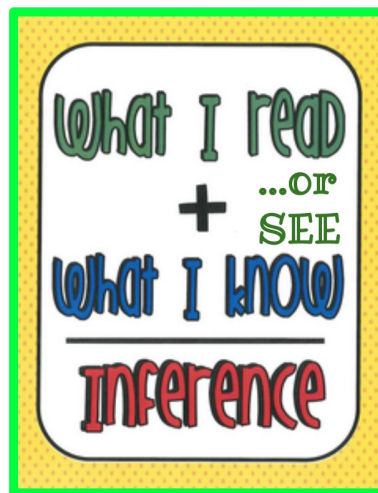
Your Task:

We have just started to inquire into **time.**

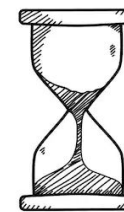
Your Task:

Become a detective!
Go around your home and find as many different items in the house that measure time.

You could record these items in a list, or you could sketch them and label the sketches.

In sentences record what the item does and how it measures time.

Try your best to find at least 5 different items.



Eg. This sand timer measures a minute. It shows a minute has passed when all the sand has moved from one side to the next.



Eg. *I infer that* the little girl has fallen off her bike *because I can see* that the bike is on the upside down behind her *and I know* that when you fall over you cry and hold the area that hurts.
